Anotace:

Pracovní list je zaměřen na procvičení tvoření doplňujících otázek v přítomném čase průběhovém. Žáci se ptají typickými tázacími výrazy (kdy, kdo, kde/kam co/jaký). Při kladení otázek žáci používají předepsané tázací slovo, nebo se ptají na vyznačenou informaci v textu.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS QUESTIONS WITH WHEN, WHERE, WHAT AND WHO



Look at the examples:

When are you singing?	When is he singing?	I'm/He's singing now.
What are you eating?	What is he eating?	I'm/He's eating eggs.
Where are you going?	Where is he going?	I'm/He's going out.

Remember how questions with who are formed:

Who is playing basketball with you? Tony is playing basketball with me.
 Who isn't skating with you? Jane isn't skating with us.

Ask questions using when, where or what:

Ask questions using who:

She is going shopping just now.

 My friend is swimming in the sea.

 She is climbing a mountain.

 My teacher isn't walking her dog now.

 Sue isn't painting a portrait.

 I'm not fighting with Tom.

Ask questions to the underlined parts of the sentences as in the example:

We are playing volleyball now.
 Who is playing volleyball now?
 When are you playing volleyball?
 He is drinking coffee in the dining room.

We are going to the cinema.

You are singing two songs today.

 She is writing a letter at the moment.

My mum is cutting her hair.

 Tom is staying at a hotel this weekend.
