POLITE QUESTIONS

jazyková úroveň: mírně pokročilí

pomůcky: příloha 20A

postup: přečtěte si pokyn na lístečku a vytvořte zdvořilou otázku podle příkladu. Rozlišuje přitom odlišnou formulaci otázek dle osoby, se kterou mluvíte:

- * běžná otázka (Will / Can ...?)
- ** zdvořilá otázka (Would / Could... please?)
- ***velmi zdvořilá otázka (mind / wonder ...)

příklad: 1) Žádáme, aby pro nás něco udělala druhá osoba

You want your schoolmate to be quiet*

Can / Will you please be quiet?

You want your darling to send you a message from France**

Would you please send me a message when you get there?

You want your teacher to come to your desk***

I wonder if you'd mind coming to my desk?

2) Prosíme druhou osobu o souhlas s naším jednáním

Ask your workmate if you can speak to him*

Can I speak to you, John?

Ask your friend if you can borrow his car**

Could I possibly borrow your car for a day or two?

Ask a famous person if you can take a photo***

Would you mind if I took a photo of yours, please?

varianta 1:

- práce ve dvojici: studenti si navzájem dávají zdvořilé otázky a krátké odpovědi.

příklad: S1: *Could I possibly borrow your car for a day or two?*

S2: *I'm afraid you couldn't.*

S1: *Why not?*

S2: *Because you are a very bad driver!*

You want a waiter to bring you another cup of coffee**	You want a shop-assistant to show you some postcards**
Ask your boss if you can take a day off***	Ask your workmate if you can speak to him for a moment*
Ask your friend if you can borrow his car**	Ask the company if you can leave now**
Ask your spouse if you can taste the food*	Ask your mother if you can pay her a visit next weekend*
Ask your teacher if you can leave his lesson sooner**	Ask the others if you can open the windows**
Ask a famous artist if you can take a photo of him***	Ask the town mayor if you can have an appointment***
Ask the president for an autograph***	Ask the plumber to repair your dripping tap*
