# Czech system of education

- Creche or nursery (jesle)
- Kindergarten or nursery school (MŠ)
- Primary school (ZŠ)
- Secondary school (SŠ)
- Higher education – university, college,.....

# Creche or nursery (jesle)

- For babies under the age of 3.
- They were common in past (during the communist period, mothers started to work early after the birth of their children).
- After the revolution most of them were closed.
- Nowadays – only a few in big towns, they are quite expensive.

# Kindergartens or nursery schools

- Age For children from 3 to 6 (7) years
- Content (activities) Singing songs, poems, playing with toys, going for walks, learning to draw,...

# Primary schools



- Age

6 – 15 years

- Content  
(activities)

1st grade : learning to write,  
read, count

2nd grade: learning more about  
the world, nature, physics,  
geography,...

# School subjects



- Maths
- Languages
- Biology
- History
- Geography
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Economics
- IT (information technology)
- PE (physical education)
- Music
- Art

# Secondary schools



- Age 15-18 (19) years
- Content (activities) Getting more knowledge(skills) from different areas

# Types of secondary schools

- Gymnasium (grammar school) – matura exam, preparation for university
- Specific secondary schools (of business, health, technical,..) – matura exam
- Vocational school (učiliště)- vocational certificate

# Maturita exam (final exam, graduation exam)

- Students take this exam at the age of 18 (19)
- Compulsory subjects
- Optional subjects
- Written, oral and practical parts of the exam

# Higher education



- Age

18 +

- Content (activities)

Further studies in different areas (it depends on the college)– finally getting the degree of master or doctorate

# British system of education

- Kindergartens or nursery schools (about half of the children attend them)
- Primary schools (5-11)
  - 1st grade: infant school (5-7 years)
  - 2nd grade junior school (7-11 years)
- Comprehensive (secondary) schools (11-16)

At 16 – exam 0 level or GCSE level

Some continue till 18 ( A level exam – important for entrance to a university)
- Higher education (university or college of further education – general, vocational or technical)

# American system of education

- Kindergartens or nursery schools (5-6)
- Elementary schools (6-12)
- Secondary (called high) schools (13-18)
  - junior high school (13-14)
  - senior high school (14-18)No national exams, important continuous assessment
- College (2 years) or university (4 years) – master's degrees or doctorates
