Present Simple Key Words

- **How often** do you go to school by bus?
- I **always** go there by bus. **100%**
- **normally = usually** **>90%**
- **often = frequently** **>50%**
- **sometimes = occasionally** **<50%**
- **seldom = rarely = hardly ever** **<10%**
- **never** **0%**

Present Simple Key Words

- **How often** do you go to school by car?
- **Sometimes** I go there by car.
- **From time to time**
- **At times**
- **Now and then**

Present Simple Key Words

- **How often** do you read your mail?
- I read it **every time**.
- **every hour**
- **every day = daily**
- **every week = weekly**
- **every month = monthly**
- **every year = yearly = annually**

Present Simple Key Words

- **When** do you watch TV?
- I watch TV **in the evenings**.
- **on Fridays**
- **at weekends**

Present Simple Key Words

- **How often** do you drink tea?
- I drink tea **regularly**.
- **once a day**
- **twice a week = 2 times a week**
- **three times a month**
- **four times a year**

Present Continuous Key Words

- **When** are you going home?
- I'm going home **now**.
- **at the moment**
- **this afternoon**
- **today**
- **tonight**
- **soon**

Past Simple Key Words

- **When** did you get the book?
- I got it **yesterday**.
- **the day before yesterday**
- **three days ago**
- **before Christmas**
- **when I was in England**

Past Simple Key Words

- **When** did you see the film?
- I saw it **last time**.
- **last week**
- **last month**
- **last year**
- **in 2012**
- **on 5 May 2012**

Present Perfect Key Words

- Have you done your work **yet**?
- I have **just** done it. (not long time ago)
- I have **already** done it.
- I have done it **recently**.
- I have **not** done it **yet**.

Present Perfect Key Words

- Have you **ever** been to England?
- I have **never** been there.
- **How many times** have you been there?
- I have been there **once**.
- **twice**
- **many times**

Present Perfect Key Words

- **How long** have you studied English?
- I have studied it **since 2006**.
- **since I was ten**
- **since seven years ago**
- **for seven years**
