Charlotte Brontë (1816 - 1855)

Charlotte Brontë was an English novelist and (1)..... . She was the (2)..... of the three Brontë sisters. Her younger sisters Emily (1818 - 1848) and Anne (1820 - 1849) were writers too.

Charlotte's father Patrick Brontë was an (3) clergyman. His surname was originally Brunty but he changed it into Brontë, because it (4)..... better. He and his wife Maria had six children, but Maria was ill and died in 1821. Her sister Elizabeth (5) the children after her death.

The Brontë family lived in (6) , a village on the Yorkshire moors. Next to their house there was an old cemetery and the Brontë children used to play there. Their house was isolated from the rest of the village, so they usually played on their own.

In 1824, their father sent Charlotte, Emily and their two older sisters Maria and Elizabeth to school at Cowan Bridge in Lancashire. It was a horrible school. It was cold there and the girls were(7) all the time. Because of this Maria and Elizabeth fell ill and both of them (8) in 1825. Charlotte used the school as the model for Lowood school in *Jane Eyre*.

The Brontë sisters all (9) to write stories at an early age. At first they used (10) Currer (Charlotte), Ellis (Emily) and Acton (Anne) Bell. They all went on to publish (11) Charlotte's most famous novel is called *Jane Eyre*, Emily's (12) and Anne's *The Tenant of Wildfell Hall*.

Jane Eyre was published in 1847 and it was a best-seller. Charlotte's other books - *Shirley*, *Villette* and *The Professor* were not so (13)Charlotte became a well-known author. in 1854,
