Did she have any brothers or sisters? If so, how many? What were their names? - She had four sisters and a brother. Her sisters were called Maria, Elizabeth, Emily and Anne, her brother's name was Branwell.

Were any of her siblings famous? If so, why? - Her sisters Emily and Anne were famous because they were novelists as well.

Where did she live? - She lived in Haworth, Yorkshire.

What did her parents do? - Her mother died soon, her father was an Anglican clergyman.

Did she get any education? If so, what? - She went to Clergy Daughter's School in Lancashire, but it wasn't a good school. She used it as a model for Lowood from *Jane Eyre*.

Did she work? If so, what did she do? - She was a poet and a novelist, but for some time she also worked as a governess.

What is the name of her most famous book? - It's called *Jane Eyre*.
