Where did little Jane grow up? Was it a nice place for a child? Why?/ Why not? - She grew up at Lowood school, which wasn't a nice place at all, because the teachers were too strict, it was cold there and the girls couldn't feel any love there.

What did Jane do when she grew up? - She decided to leave Lowood and find a job.

What was Thornfield Hall? What was it like? Why did Jane go there? - It was a manor whose owner, Mr. Rochester, was Jane's employer. She worked there as a governess for Adele, a little French girl.

What people did Jane meet at Thornfield? Explain who they were. She met Mr. Rochester - the master of the house, Mrs. Fairfax - the housekeeper, Adele and several servants.

How did Jane save Mr. Rochester's life? - She woke him up at night when his room was in fire.
