- e) Was there a completely bad character in the film? If so, who was it? - **Bill Sykes was a completely bad character - he was mean, selfish, cruel to people and animals. He didn't respect other people.**
- f) Why did Mr. Brownlow look after Oliver? - **He was very kind and wanted Oliver to have a better life. He could feel there was goodness in Oliver.**
- g) Was Bill Sykes punished for his crimes? Explain your answer. - **pupils' own opinion**
- h) Why did Oliver want to visit Fagin in prison? - **He pitied Fagin and liked him at the same time.**
