a/ William Shakespeare

Correct some mistakes in Shakespeare' s biography:

He was born in Stratford upon Avon on 23rd April 1564. He was born to John Shakespeare – dramatist – and Mary Arden. At the age 20, he married Ann Hathaway, with whom he had three children: Susanna and twins Hamneth and Judith. Judith died of unknown causes at the age of 11. Between 1585 and 1592, he began his successful career in London as an actor, poet and dramatist. He became a part – owner of a playing company called Lord Chamberlain' s Men, later known as the Queen' s Men. He wrote mainly tragedies as Hamlet, Othello, King Lear, Romeo and Juliet and As You Like It. He was also the author of many comedies such as: Merry Wives of Windsor, The Merchant of Venice and Volpone the Fox. He was admired by the Queen Victoria, who supported theatrical activity. He was the owner of the Globe theatre, which was built in London.
