### Answer key:

#### 1)

- 1) Why did Jane have to live with her aunt Mrs. Reed? - Because her parents had died, she was an orphan.
- 2) Why do you think she was mistreated there by her aunt and her children? - Aunt Reed's husband wished Jane lived with his family before he died, but his wife hated Jane and thought she was a burden. That's why she abused Jane. Mrs. Reed was a thoroughly hateful character, there was no good in her.
- 3) What's Jane's personality like? - She is a kind, sensitive and independent young woman. She can look after herself.
- 4) Could you describe in detail what methods of „education“ were used at Lowood school? - The girls were severely punished for only small offences, sometimes even unjustly. The education was really tough and the living conditions were extremely harsh.
- 5) What typical features did the majority of staff have at Lowood? - Some of them were cruel, even brutal people.
- 6) Why was the relationship between Jane and Helen Burns so strong? - Both of them were looking for somebody kind, loving who would support them mentally.
- 7) In what ways was the adult Jane different from other women of her age? - She was independent. She could make her own living.
- 8) Why in your opinion did Mr. Rochester fall in love with her? Why did she fall in love with him? - They both had a lot in common - their previous lives were unhappy, they were looking for a soul mate.
- 9) What sort of person was Mr. Rochester? Try to describe him in detail. - Although he wasn't handsome, there was something attractive in him, he was a straightforward person, not pretending anything. He was intelligent, too.
