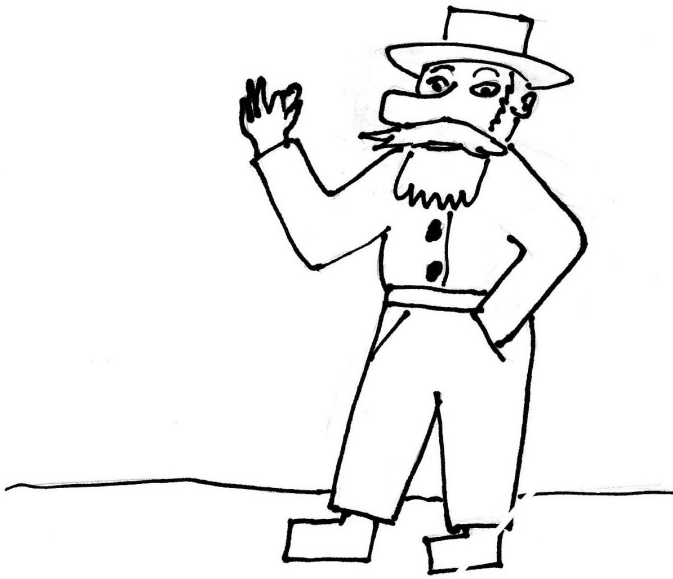

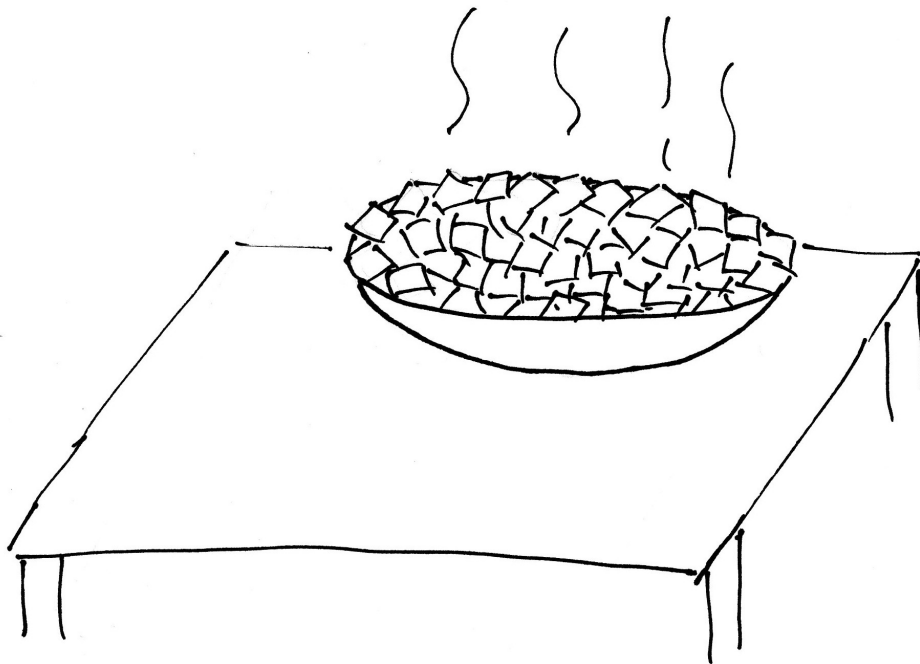
They see a mouse. "Come and help!" they say.
