On 19 October the Metropolitan Police Service **launched** a formal criminal investigation, Operation Yewtree, into historic allegations of child sexual abuse by Savile and other people, some of whom **were still living**, over four decades. They **stated** that they **were pursuing** over 400 separate lines of inquiry, **based** on evidence of 200 witnesses, via 14 police forces across the UK. They **described** the alleged abuse as being "on an unprecedented scale", and the number of potential victims as "staggering". On 25 October the police **claimed** that the number of possible victims **was** 300, and on 15 November **reported** that the number **had reached** 450.
