# Museum Madame Tussaud's

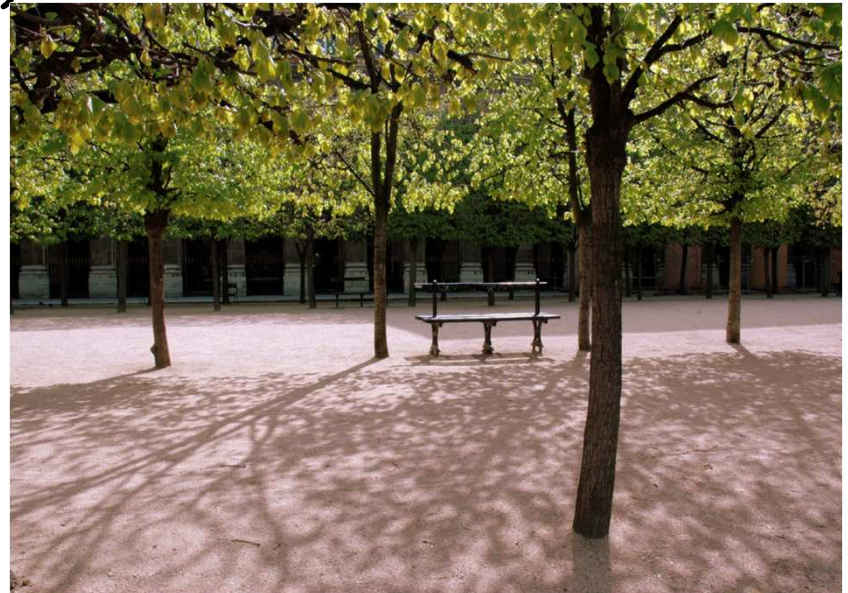
- A very popular tourist attraction in London, displaying waxworks of historical and royal figures, film stars, sports stars and famous murderers.
- Founded by Marie Tussaud (1761 - 1850)



# Parks in London

There are eight Royal parks in London

1. Green park (16 ha)
2. St. James's Park (34 ha)
3. Hyde Park (140 ha)
4. Kensingtons Gardens (111 ha)
5. Regent's Park (197 ha)
6. Greenwich Park (73 ha)
7. Bushy Park (450 ha)
8. Richmond Park (955 ha)



# Hyde Park

- Speakers' corner - an area where public speaking, debate and discussion are allowed. It is in the north-east corner of Hyde Park in London.
