- 2. St. James's Park (34 ha)
- 3. Hyde Park (140 ha)
- 4. Kensingtons Gardens (111 ha)
- 5. Regent's Park (197 ha)
- 6. Greenwich Park (73 ha)
- 7. Bushy Park (450 ha)
- 8. Richmond Park (955 ha)





Hyde Park

 Speakers'corner - an area where public speaking, debate and discussion are allowed. It is in the north-east corner of Hyde Park in London.
