

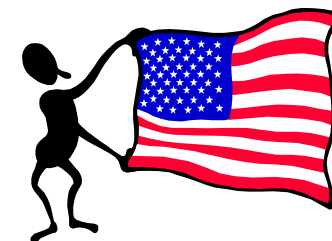

The sunflower is the Kansas State Flower.

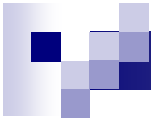
Kansas is at the very centre of the
