

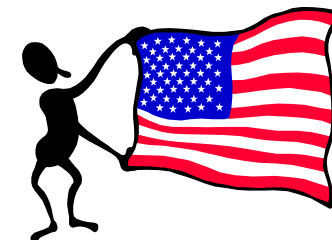

Hershey, Pennsylvania.



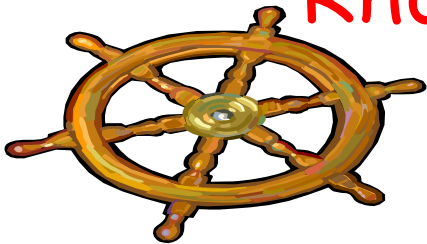

Nashville's nickname is „Music City“.

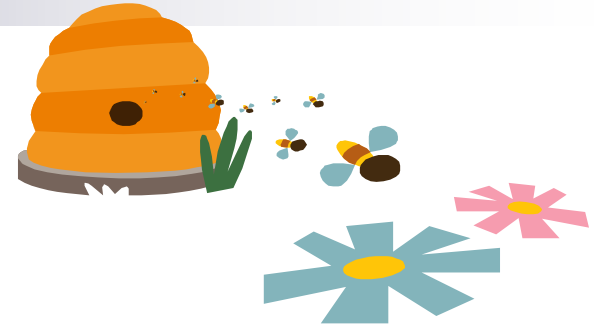
- Texas (Austin)

Texas has some largest cattle ranches in the world.



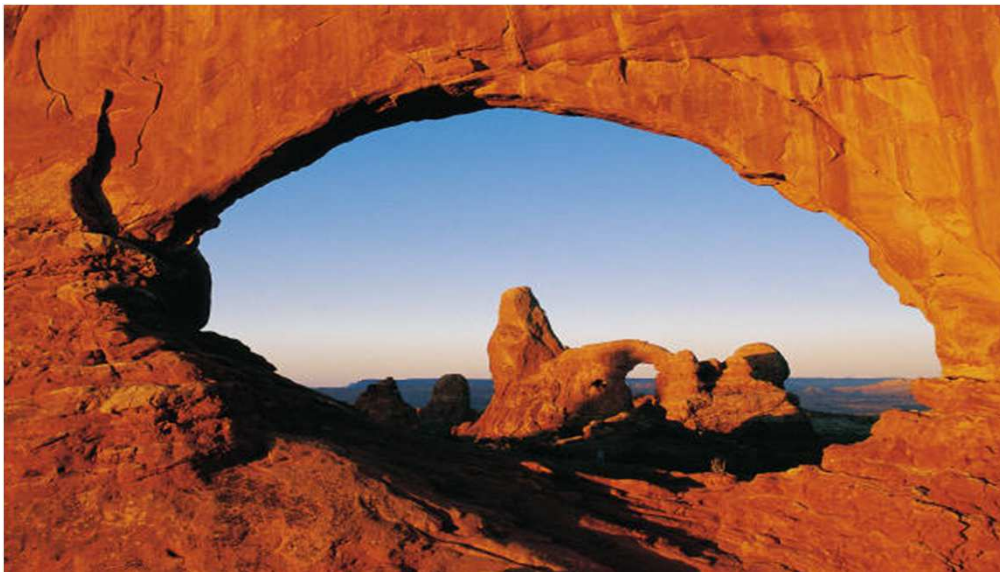
