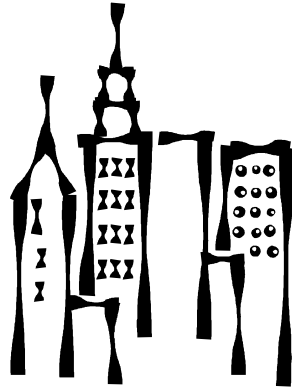

MY TOWN



1. Read the text about Sokolov.

Hello, let me tell you something about my town. I live in Sokolov in the west of the Czech Republic. Sokolov is a small town between Karlovy Vary and Cheb on the river Ohře. There live about 25 thousand people.

Sokolov was founded in 1279. The legend says that it was found by a knight Sebastian. He was a medicine man and lived at the confluence of the Ohře and Svatava. He kept falcons and used them for hunting. Sokolov has got a falcon in its coat of arms.

The town was damaged by wars and fires several times, and built up again. A lot of beautiful historical buildings remind the rich history. You can see the Parish Church of Saint Jacob the Major – the most remarkable building in the Old Square. Then there is Capuchin Monastery on the other end of the Old Square. Concerts and weddings are held there. Sokolov famous beer Permon is brewed here. There is a crypt under the monastery with mummies of members of the Nostitz family. Near the monastery we can find Holy Trinity Chapel. When we go back to the St. Jacob's church we can see historical Town Hall on the right. In the centre of the square there is a fountain with a statue of Sebastian – the falconer, Anniversary fountain, and Marian Column.

Another historical building is the chateau. It is in the park Husovy Sady. The chateau is a square pink building with 4 round towers and a fountain in the centre. There is the museum, the library, and the exhibition hall inside the chateau.

The park is very nice, too. You can relax there at two ponds with ducks. There runs the Lobežský potok through the park among beautiful trees and bushes.

Now, we are not far from the New Square. There is the House of Miners – the Sokolov cultural centre, some shops and the town hall.

People in Sokolov live in family houses, blocks of flats, and prefabricated houses. They can go to see a film in the 3D cinema, swim in the swimming pool, do or watch sports in the sports stadium.

There are some of kindergartens, basic schools, and high schools in our town. If you want to see all the town and its surrounding you should climb up the watchtower near the cemetery.

You will see the Sokolov biggest factory – Chemické závody. There is a large hospital and some health centres in Sokolov, too. People can travel by train to Cheb or Karlovy Vary, and by bus to other towns and villages, or round the town.

I like living here. The streets are clean, old houses are repaired. You can go to the cinema or to the theatre, play sports, cycle or just walk. I think, it's a nice place to live.
