Speaking activity - different situations for role-playing:

1) At a restaurant

Situation: You want to order some meal... /ex.: chicken with chips, a tomato salad, a glass of juice/

Roles: a waiter and a customer

Phrases: Can I have..., please? Anything to drink? Can I ask for the bill, please?

2) In a clothes shop

Situation: You want to buy some new jeans.

Roles: a shop assistant and a customer

Phrases: Can I help you? - Can I try these jeans on? – The changing rooms are over there.
– How are they? They're fine. / They're too small. I need bigger ones., How much are they? They're 50 pounds.

3) At home in England

Situation: You want to say that you don't like the meal or that you are allergic to some food.

Try to think what you don't like or if you are allergic to sth and tell it.

Roles: mother of the family and you as the guest

Phrases: I am allergic to..., I am a vegetarian., I don't like this meal., I would like to add the food.

Ok, it doesn't matter. I'll prepare something different, for example...

4) At the Museum

Situation: You would like to see the exhibition at Madam Tussaud and you are going to make a conversation between the ticket seller and the customer. The customer wants to know when it opens, when it closes, how much the ticket costs and what you can see there.

Roles: a ticket seller and a customer

Phrases: When does it open? When does it close? / What are the opening hours? – The opening hours are from ... to ... How much is the ticket? – It's ...

What can I see there? - You can see there many wax figurines of famous people from all over the world.

5) On the street

Situation: You are lost and you want to find the way. Imagine that you are standing in front of a restaurant and you want to go to the nearest school – ask somebody.

Roles: a lost person and a passer-by

Phrases: Excuse me, how can I get to the school? / Can you tell me the way to the nearest school here? - Turn left / turn right / go straight on... and there it is.

6) At the Doctor

Situation: You have a flu or a bad cold and you are at the doctor. Tell the doctor about your health problem.

Roles: a doctor and a patient

Phrases: How can I help you? / What can I do for you? – I don't feel well. I have a cold.

Do you have a temperature? – Yes / No. Sometimes I feel hot and sometimes I feel cold.

- Ok, here, take this medicine for 5 days and get lots of rest.

7) In a chemist shop

Situation: You want to buy a shampoo, a toothbrush and a tooth-paste. Ask the shop assistant for the things.

Roles: a shop assistant and a customer

Phrases: I need... / I would like to buy ... How much is this shampoo?, It is too expensive. Can I have a look at the other one? – Here you are.

8) At school

Situation: You are at your new school in England and you need to ask the teacher some questions. You want to know when the breaks are, what lessons you are going to have, when the school starts, when it finishes, ...

Roles: a teacher and a student

Phrases: Excuse me, can I ask you some questions? When do the lessons start/finish?
When do we have breaks?, How much time is for the break?

9) At the bus stop

Situation: You are at the bus stop and you need to ask what time it is and which bus you should take to get to the center.

Roles: an asking person and a passer-by

Phrases: Excuse me, what's the time, please?, How can I get to the center?, Which bus should I take? – Take the bus number ... and get off at ... (ex.: Elm station).
